OVERVIEW

Short for "mouton à cinq pattes" or five-legged sheep in French, in English you would say that Les Cinq Pattes are something of rare bird. VINEYARD

Soil: Chalky-clay and sandy-clay.

Location : The selected grape varieties of Sauvignon blanc, Sémillon and Muscadelle, come from vineyards located in the North of the Gironde, between the Dordogne and the Garonne rivers. The main features of these soil areas is the high capacity of getting and keeping rainwater and sun's heat, making them ideal for vines. Moreover this region enjoys a sunny and scarce rain climate.

MAKING PROCESS

Partial skin-maceration. Low-temperature fermentation. Ageing on thin lees.

TASTING NOTE

The wine displays beautiful bright colour with green highlights. The bouquet expresses fine and fruity aromas, reminding scents of peach abd exotic fruits. Pleasant feshness on the palate and good liveliness in the finish.

AGEING POTENTIAL: Less than 3 years
